

Council Minutes
Special Called Meeting
August 18, 2020

Unfinished Business: Ordinance Second Reading:

Ordinance No. 2020-24 - to approve the sale of 122 Folger Ave. to Silo Holdings, LLC, a limited liability corporation in South Carolina, and establish a mortgage on the property for the remaining amount owed per lease agreement. Councilman Garrison made the motion to approve with a second from Councilman Moore. City Attorney, Brian James gave a brief explanation. There were no changes in the ordinance since first reading. The milestones requirements will be added to the mortgage language.
