2019 Fall for the Arts Rules and Regulations

1. All exhibitors must unload cars and park in a designated parking area.
Please set up your booth AFTER you have parked.
2. You will be issued a booth number by September 16, 2019. Spaces will be marked.
3. All arts and crafts must be homemade. No resale items or flea market items will be acceptable. We reserve the right to reject any application or to remove any unacceptable work from the exhibit. We will inspect the booths during the day.
4. No food items are to be sold in arts and crafts booths.
5. You will need to bring your own chairs, tables, tent (10x10) and displays and other necessities. The Easley Farmers Market no longer rents tents.
6. **Do not pack up your booth until the festival is over at 3:00 p.m. NO CARS ARE ALLOWED IN THE PARKING LOT UNTIL 3:00 P.M. IF YOU HAVE TO LEAVE FOR SOME REASON YOU WILL HAVE TO WALK YOUR ITEMS OUT TO YOUR VEHICLE. **I CAN NOT STRESS THIS ENOUGH. VIOLATORS WILL NOT BE INVITED BACK. THIS IS FOR THE SAFETY OF CUSTOMERS, VENDORS, AND CHILDREN.**
7. No alcoholic beverages, drugs, smoking or vaping will be permitted.
8. The collection and payment of permits, license, taxes, etc. shall be the responsibility of the exhibitor. Please make sure you check with the SC Dept. of Revenue for sales tax information.
9. **Applications with payment are to be mailed to City of Easley, P.O. Box 466, Easley, SC 29641, Attn: Lisa Chapman deadline is September 9th, 2019**
10. This is a rain or shine event, no refunds will be given.
11. Rest rooms are at the amphitheater.
12. If you are a food vendor please make sure you follow all the guidelines for food safety as required by DHEC and SCDA. This information is on our website at www.cityofeasley.com, click on the farmers market tab, under rules and certifications.
13. We limit the number of vendors selling the same type item. Vendors will go through an approval process. We do allow businesses like, Pampered Chef, Avon, etc BUT only one per business.
