

ADDENDUM #4

Amendment to Due Date/Time

Please note that the Due Date/Time has been delayed from December 29, 2020 at 2:00 pm until Tuesday, January 5, 2020 at 2:00 pm.

This is to allow time to finalize pricing after answers about charge for dumping in the Pickens County Landfill, and to account for the holidays.

Questions Received

Will there be a charge for dumping at the Pickens County Landfill?

- There will be no fees charged for dumping at the Pickens County Landfill that need to be included in your pricing. However, please note the following:
 - The City will have a set tonnage that we receive at a free rate and will be responsible to pay overages. This rate is based on our past 3 years average of MSW that the City has taken to the Pickens County Landfill.
 - All bidders will need to have RFID chips in cans, GPS for trucks, cameras, or any other measure or combination of measures to ensure that all trash disposed of at the Pickens County Landfill is collected from inside the City of Easley. The City may ask for proof of routes and collection should the tonnage begin to exceed our allowance. Should waste be collected outside the city and disposed at Pickens County, the contractor will pay for that tonnage.
 - The contractor will need to ensure that weigh tickets are collected, and that the tonnage matches reports from the County.
 - Other details can be worked out during contract negotiations.

- No other questions will be answered after this addendum and there will be no further delay in the submittal due date.
